3. Report on 2011 State Rally @ Corvallis (Bud)

a. Dates: September 2-5, 2011

b. Theme is PATRIOTIC

Then Bud informed the staff that there is a Beaver Home football game on Saturday 3 September. The only hotels available are on the other side of town and the cheapest Hotel would be Motel 6 at \$69 plus tax if they weren't booked already. In talking with several Hotels they say they will be booked full within a week of the schedule being posted. No hotel would block any rooms for us. Dave Bennie and Rick McWhorter both stated that most of Chapter P would probably only attend a single day if there wasn't any hotels available close since most all of them do not do camping.



A major safety issue was brought up about motorcycles and intoxicated people driving cars to and from the game. Since Bud & Nancy were informed that the parking lot at the fair grounds is used for overflow parking with shuttle service from the fair grounds to the game and back.

Last year when John Day was selected as the #1 location for 2010 Corvallis was #2 and would be the site for 2011 and we did just that since Bud already signed the rental agreement with no funds required until 30 day prior to event. There is a \$25 cancellation fee for Corvallis if we do it more than 30 days before the event.

The entire staff present recommended that we go back to the chapters for their input.
